

Feedback Report 2020-21

The session also witnessed the curse of covid, proving hurdles for smooth session. On the basis of analysis made by feedback committee in the meeting held on 26-11-202, following conclusion were drawn which were summarised and forwarded to the Principal for consideration –

1- The overall teacher's assessment have risen from 66.0% to 78.0% from 2019-20 to 2020-21, respectively, which is a positive indication that college administration has tried to focus attention for resolving issues regarding the teachers. Teachers are highly satisfied with parameters like separate toilets for ladies and gents hygienic conditions in the college, laboratory equipments, stress free environment, involvement of teachers in decision making, effective functioning of grievance redressal, smooth functioning of sanctioning leave, personal storage facility, co-ordination of teachers with administration, secrecy of feedback, work load to teachers as per norms, timely increment, salary, promotion and arrear. Teachers are satisfied to some extent with separate cabins for teachers, guest house facility, residential facility for staff, and availability of computer for each faculty member and proper utilization of teacher welfare fund; this is where exactly the improvement is marked. Satisfaction is also marked with availability of journals, books, encyclopedia, software, internet connection, condition of class rooms and parking facilities.

However the teachers seemed to be unsatisfied with the parking facility of four wheelers, health insurance policy for teachers, and common room facility for staff, medical facility, canteen facility and availability of crèche. This is where the administration needs to focus on.

2- The non-teaching staff too is satisfied with the process of granting leaves, infrastructure of college, co-ordination between staff and college, stress free working atmosphere, opportunity provided for professional growth. Where as they are satisfied with health insurance facility and common room facility. Crèche is the only factor they are unsatisfied with.

They are highly satisfied with smooth sanctioning of leave process, uniform, medical facility, proper utilization of welfare fund, timely arrears, stress free environment, timely bonus, lunch break, separate toilet for ladies and gents, work load as per norms, timely increment, timely salary, hygienic conditions, personal storage facility, parking facility, drinking water, canteen, co-ordination between staff and administration, stress free environment, secrecy of feedback. However non-teaching staff is not unsatisfied with any

3- Teachers satisfaction with the course content in 69% respectively, an average of 7 to 8 percent is provided for quality of content, extent of course coverage, practically applicable, concept, broad perspectives clarity and relevance of content also the availability of course materials.

4- Students feedback about college reveals that the students have ranked the college above satisfactory, they are not unsatisfied with any of the parameters for the college. Students are highly satisfied with discipline, library, canteen, sports, drinking water facility, book bank, parking, canteen, drinking water, cultural activities, job, opportunity, anti ragging cell, prior information of important notices and Principal's interaction.

Students were also the students mark satisfactory with first aid, toilets, internet connection, financial aid for weaker sections, condition for laboratories, remedial classes, sports, drinking water facility, book bank, canteen, girls common room, cultural activities, job opportunity, campus parking and ragging cell, prior information to important notices and Principal's interaction.

Students for the whole students don't mark unsatisfactory to any parameter for the college.

5- Overall all the students also mark college up to satisfactory level for all 27 parameters. They are highly satisfied with college infrastructure, academic discipline, library facility, suitable college timings, sports and safety measures, extra co-curricular activities parking facility, girls common room, environment awareness programmers, emergency exit, Book bank, discipline, fine fees structure, students uniform, scholarship, co-operation of staff, regular communication of teachers and parents and ragging free campus.

Students are also satisfied with job oriented courses, laboratory, placement cell, girls section, first aid, medical facility, remedial classes and sports, Rovers and S. Rovers and Rangers.

6- Overall all the undergraduate students and the students of self-finance classes are highly satisfied with the functioning of NSS, NCC, Rovers and Rangers along with academic discipline and the main focus is where administration needs to focus on.

Students for the whole college marks improvement on all the parameters for the college. This is a positive indicator of administrator's focus over on the improvement of the college.



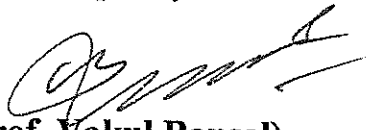

Feedback Report 2021-22

As the session 2021-22 witnessed major change with start of Semester System in U.G. Classes which proved a massive change under NEP with the introduction of Skill Development Courses and Vocational Courses. However with full co-operation of teachers, non-teaching, students and guardians it was possible to conclude with feedback well in time of the session. On the basis of analysis made by feedback committee in the meeting held on the 15.02.2021 following conclusions were drawn which were summarized and forwarded to the Principal for further consideration-

1. Teachers are highly satisfied with the working conditions and overall appraisal of the college, only except that for availability of common room for staff, health insurance facility for staff, availability of crèche, the canteen facility was however met this session.
2. In all the teachers are highly satisfied with the course content providing an average of 70 % on the whole for the same.
3. The non-teaching staff is also satisfied with the overall conditions prevailing in the college only except the average which goes to availability of common room facility, health insurance policy and availability of crèche.
4. Henceforth both teaching and non-teaching staff marks average for health insurance policy to staff, common room facility, availability to crèche and canteen. These are the variables where college and administration needs to focus on.
5. Things to notice is facility of health insurance to staff, common room facility, availability of crèche are marked low since 2010, hence the college and administration needs to focus their attention for the same.
6. The students are highly satisfied with the college only except few factors like absence of weekend tours and camps, NCC, NSS, Rovers and Rangers which are marked low to the mark since 2010, more efforts are required to be made.
7. The students are satisfied on the whole with entire college staff from average to high level of satisfaction level.
8. College staff are highly satisfied with college and staffs; better part is that the administration needs to focus on improvement for level of satisfaction for the functions like NCC, NSS, Rovers and Rangers in 2021-22, respectively.

The overall analysis and feedback analysis makes evident that teachers, non-teaching staff, students and guardians are satisfied with college and its administration. However, some parameters as mentioned above needs to be



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
