Feedback Report 2022-23

On the basis of analysis made by feedback committee on the 26th of April, following conclusions were drawn which were summarized and forwarded to the Principal for further considerations:-

- Teachers are highly satisfied with the working conditions and overall appraisal of the college, only except that for availability of common room for staff, health insurance facility for staff and availability of crèche.
- In all the teachers are highly satisfied with the course content providing an average of 80% for the same.
- The non-teaching staff is also satisfied with the overall conditions prevailing in the college only except the average which is for health insurance policy and availability of crèche.
- Drinking water facility is just average as RO is demanded to instal in every department for safe drinking water.
- Upcoming with NEP teachers feel the need of more classrooms to be built.
- NCC, NSS, Rovers and Rangers achieved new heights with multiple activities and camps, the number of students registered under these units also increased.
- Students are satisfied on the whole with entire college staff from average to higher satisfaction.
- Guardians too are highly satisfied with the college administration and staff. The level of Guardians satisfaction increased from past few sessions which is a positive indicator.
- Teachers and students are extraordinarily satisfied by the steps taken from college administration in order to maintain the ecology and environment of college premises by taking steps like wrapping the college with greenery of trees and plants, installing nests for sparrows, making manure with shed leaves, provision of dustbins all over the college, two water harvesting plants to maintain underground water level and installing solar panels to conserve power.

As such the feedback analysis makes clear that the teachers, non-teaching staff, students as well as guardians are highly satisfied with the heights which college is achieving every year which shows a positive growth and reflects harmony between administration, teaching staff and students respectively.
